In order to sob in private, Meena seeks refuge from her hateful job in a ladies' underwear section at a local department store. One day, while crying amidst a rack of undergarments, she meets a kind widow (Joan End) who showers her with loving counsel.

Fortunately for Meena, Schmidt Pharmaceuticals is conducting a trial study of a drug ("925"), that combats workplace depression. Meena enrolls in the trial and reports to Dr. Phil Grav (Jason Will), who's stuck in the research branch because he insulted a bratty 10-year-old during an exam. Phil also hates his job and must kowtow to his insensitive, sexist supervisor (Marilyn White), a corporate harpy who wants America popping pills morning, noon and night.
