
The City of Milwaukee's solar program, Milwaukee Shines, works to increase the interest and investment in solar energy use through a strong public-private partnership.

How Does a Solar Group Buy Work?

A neighborhood brings home and small business owners together to purchase and install solar as a community.

- **Reduced Price:** A group buy saves costs as a result of the installer bulk purchasing solar panels and equipment. The more residents participate, the lower cost will be for everyone. The price is also reduced because education and customer development is done early in the process, which saves the installer time & money.
- **Education:** Solar group buys help neighbors decide where to start, what to budget, and who to hire. We provide educational sessions on details of the technology and the program. We provide up to 8 community sessions to learn more about solar, costs, and how the group-buy program works.
- Installer Selected: An advisory team (with at least one rep from neighborhood) will select an installer through a competitive bid process to ensure quality work at a low cost to customers. The installer will be selected based on criteria important to the neighborhood (such as certification, experience, cost).
- **Enrollment:** Interested participants will receive a free site assessment from the selected installer. After receiving the free cost estimate, the customer will decide whether or not to move forward with the solar installation.

Milwaukee Shines is partnering with the Midwest Renewable Energy Association and Murray Hill Neighborhood Association to offer a solar group buy program for Milwaukee's East Side residents.
